Also we need to continue the lobby process to get sanity and common sense in relation to allowing cars to display their original black and white number plates – without paying an exorbitant price at a so called "auction" with an unrealistic reserve on all plates. The boffins in Adelaide need to realize Car Clubs are not cash cows for cash strapped Governments – but genuine family recreation for all walks of life.

So I look forward to the next 12 months and I thank you all so much for the confidence you've shown in returning, an old war horse back into the shafts after 40 years. With your involvement, I'm positive the Club has a great future and will achieve everything its member's desire.
