

## Understanding the Club Registration Scheme

Once you are a **financial** member of NARC your vehicle may be eligible for Club registration. Joint owners both have to be members.

**To obtain** Club registration you need to see one of the club's authorised persons who will issue a MR 334 form to you verifying that you are a member of NARC and your vehicle is eligible. It may also be necessary to have a vehicle identity check done if it can not be established that the vehicle has been previously registered in SA. This is done by the Police in country regions or Transport SA in metro areas.

You can now obtain your registration. (you can register for 3 years) Ask for the Extension at the time you apply. This is free and allows limited use of vehicle without using one of the 90 days of use you are entitled to.

**You are still not legally registered** and cannot drive your vehicle.

**To legally drive your vehicle** a log book must be filled in and signed each day BEFORE driving it... Only one signature per day is needed even if several people drive it. If a mechanic or similar has your vehicle overnight etc. they must sign for any days when they drive it. Do not sign for days in advance.

**To Obtain** your logbook you must get the NARC Registrar to issue one and stamp it to show that you are a current financial member. This has to be done **EVERY** June.

You MUST sign the first page of this log book to say you agree to the conditions and then fill out a line each day you drive the vehicle. Your log book must be returned to the club BEFORE 1<sup>st</sup> July to be checked and endorsed.

Even though you have paid your vehicle is UNREGISTERED unless you have :-

- 1) Signed the first page of the log book
- 2) Had the log book endorsed by NARC *EACH June*
- 3)...Enter the period of registration into the logbook each time you renew your rego
- 4) Signed and filled out a line of your log book each day before you drive.  
Carry in vehicle with you.

**NOTE** you must renew your membership before June 30<sup>th</sup> to be registered. Do not drive your vehicle after June 30<sup>th</sup> until you have paid your subs. Members un-financial after 30<sup>th</sup> August will have their registration cancelled by the Department.

Police have checked logbooks when vehicles have been photographed by speed cameras etc.

**HEAVY FINES APPLY FOR DRIVING UNREGISTERED VEHICLES.**
